General District Information

Trail of the Lakes Municipal Utility District (the "District") is a Texas local governmental entity that provides water and sanitary sewer service to Atascocita Forest, The Forest, The Park at Atascocita Forest, Clayton's Park and Clayton's Park East subdivisions. The District was created on April 26, 1974, by the Texas Water Rights Commission. The District is located 17 miles northeast of downtown Houston and 3.5 miles southeast of Humble, Texas. The District is governed by a five-member Board of Directors who regularly meet the last Monday of each month at 12:00 p.m. at the offices of Radcliffe Adams Barner PLLC, 2929 Allen Parkway, Suite 3450, Houston, Texas 77019. TRASH TALK: NO PARKING ON INTERIOR OF CUL-DE-SACS

Did you know it is illegal to park on the interior edge of a cul-de-sac? You may be subject to a ticket or towing if you park your vehicle in such a location. Further, it creates a safety hazard to you and the garbage trucks and crews, because they cannot properly navigate the cul-de-sac with the vehicles illegally parked.

SAFETY TIPS

Here are some safety tips to diminish your chances of becoming a target for criminals this holiday season:

Parking lot safety

- Lock your doors when getting in or out of your car.
- Inspect in and alongside your car before you get in.
- Park in a well-lit parking lot or under a street light.
- Ask for an escort if you feel uncomfortable walking to your car.
- Place your packages in the trunk of your car; keep them out of sight.

Self-protection tips

- Do not walk along parking lots or streets without looking around for potential danger.
- Stop frequently and observe your surroundings.
- Carry a sound making device and small flashlight.
- Give the appearance that you are alert. Keep your head up and look around. Attackers target those people they think are weak and unsuspecting.

Home and car protection

- Keep your home and car locked at all times.
- Never leave your keys in the ignition.
- Be sure to activate car and home alarms.
- Use a timer for lights.
- Stop mail and newspaper delivery when going out of town.
- Sign up for Vacation Watch with the Constable on its website at constablepct4.com.
- Do not post your out-of-town holiday plans on social networking sites.

Below is a list of **non-flushable** items that should not be disposed of in the sink, bath, or toilet. Flushing these items cause damage to the District's facilities resulting in costly repairs.
